10 miles – this walk starts in the beautiful parkland of Chatsworth House before heading to Bakewell, alongside the River Wye – one of Britain's most scenic and unspoilt rivers. The walk finishes alongside

the banks of the River Derwent with lovely views of Chatsworth House.

Chatsworth House and gardens

All participants will be offered a discounted rate for admission to the house and gardens after the walk.
