## Parkinson's: An introduction to caring for someone on your ward.

This course will take place online and you can log on at any time. It is a 10 hour course in two parts over two weeks, with a separate section each week. You will be able to look at, listen to and read various subject materials and take part in a group discussion. The course tutor will log in at times during the day to aid your discussion and answer any questions. It is recommended that you log on to the course daily.
