Your shots will help celebrate the success of those taking part and encourage others to support us in the future.

You will:

- Take high quality photos and/or video of our people, events and activities for a range of uses
- Collect a variety of images; varying the orientation and capturing participants, family and friends, performers, action and group shots
- Incorporate the Parkinson's UK brand into your activity
- Ensure individuals complete photography consent forms
- Plan with your Parkinson's UK staff contact the best way to visually represent the activity you support.

What you could get out of volunteering

- Meet others in your local community, building connections and awareness of your photography
- Use and develop existing skills in photography and client engagement
Gain experience of dealing with members of the public and supporters of Parkinson's UK
- A great day out after your volunteer shift (this could be personalised in the advert depending on where the event is held)

- You'll have your own equipment to use on the day, capable of taking high resolution images
- Able to work to a brief and create quality photography/film
- Examples of your previous photography/filming projects provided ahead of the day

- Confident communication skills, to direct people and arrange the perfect shot

- An event briefing will be provided on the morning of the event, or before, with all you need to know
