Ticket holder	At the time of submission, the presenting author must hold a valid conference ticket. Any abstracts submitted without a corresponding ticket will not be accepted.
Authors	In addition to the presenting author, you may enter <b>up to four</b> <b>additional authors</b> whose names will appear in our printed abstract booklet. All other authors can be credited on your poster or during your presentation.
Poster/ platform presentations	All accepted abstracts will <b>be included in our conference app</b> and <b>poster presentation</b> session (unless otherwise stated). A <b>small number of abstracts will also be selected</b> by our Programme Committee <b>for platform presentations</b> . If you would like to be considered for a platform presentation please indicate this in the required place during submission.
Word limit	The total word limit is <b>330</b> . This includes the title (up to 50 words), abstract body (up to 250 words) and authors and institutions (up to 30 words).
