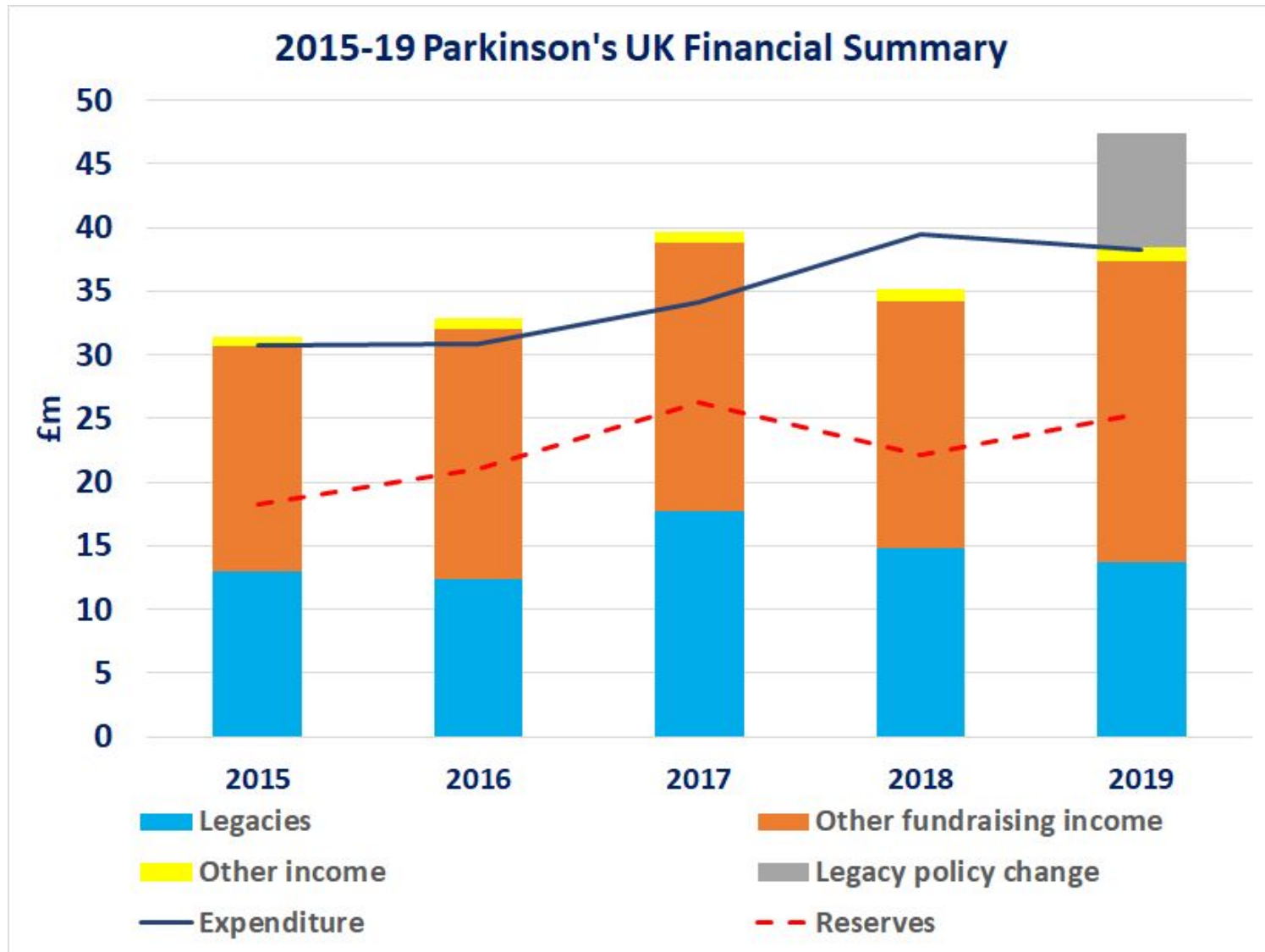

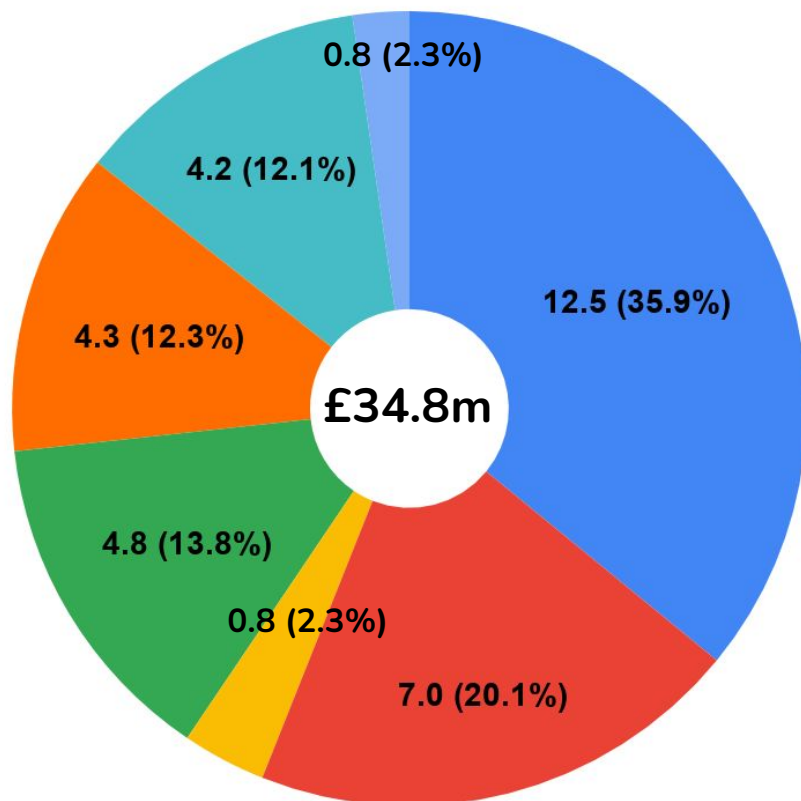


Our finances in 2020 have held up well

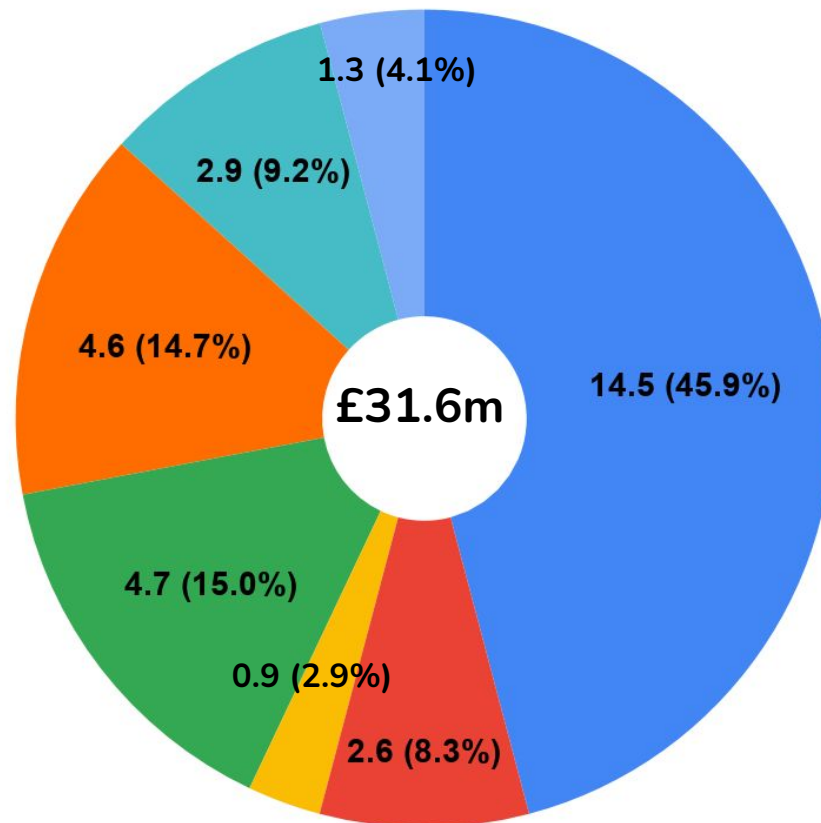

2020 Budgeted Income (£ms)

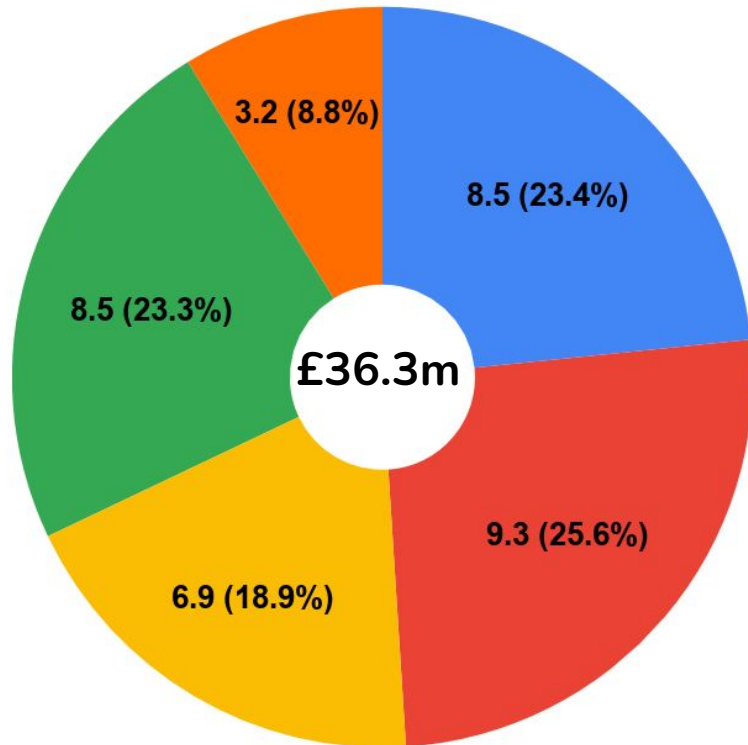


2020 Predicted Income (£ms)

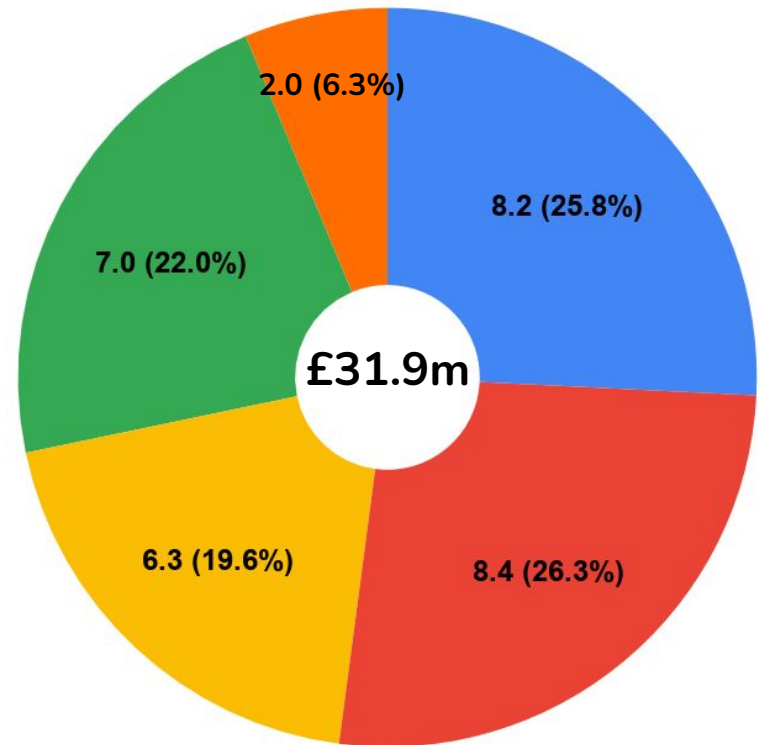


2020: Expenditure

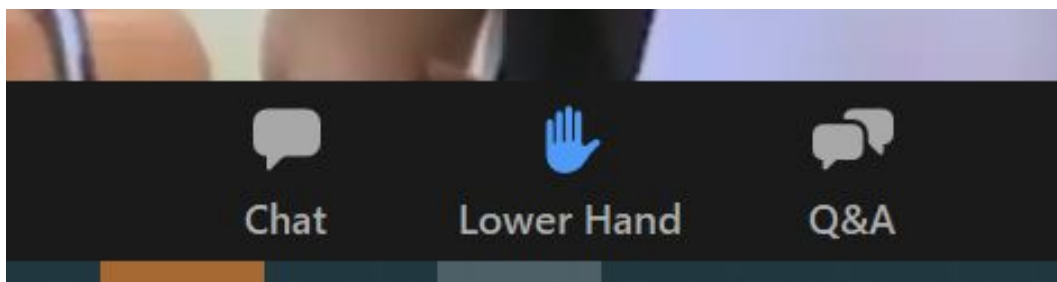
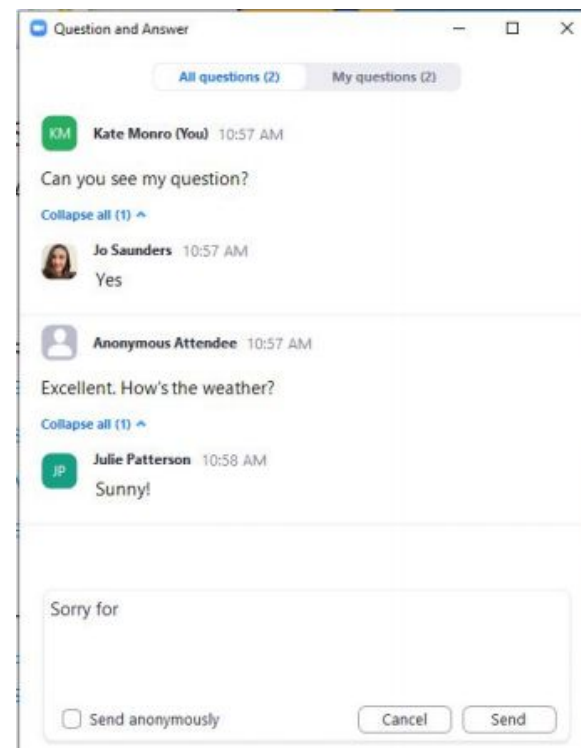
