What is Gift Aid?

If you're a UK taxpayer, you can increase the value of your donation by 25% at no extra cost to you.

So for every £1 you give Parkinson's UK, we'll get an extra 25p from HM Revenue and Customs.

How to Gift Aid your donations

Please read the Gift Aid declaration on the second page to make sure you're happy to add Gift Aid to your donation.

Each sponsor must fill in their details in their own handwriting to claim Gift Aid.

Follow these simple steps:

- Ask your sponsors to fill in their details on the form and tick the box to Gift Aid their donation(s).
- Don't forget to do the same if you've made any donations.
- Send your completed form to **Parkinson's UK, 215 Vauxhall Bridge Road, London SW1V 1EJ**. We recommend that you use a Royal Mail 'Signed for' service.
